In an effort to enrich our co-op opportunities and deepen our sense of community, the board of directors has unanimously approved adding the Greenville Homeschool Hurricane sports program to the Upstate Homeschool Co-op. The Hurricanes program has been in existence for 3 years. We are very excited about the possibilities this program will offer to our students and their families.

Under the leadership of Coach and Athletic Director Shawn Ward, the 2008-2009 school year program plans to offer boys/girl high school, middle school basketball, soccer and girls volleyball (based on participation and interest). This program will NOT be exclusive to co-op member families but will be open to the greater homeschooling community. This program is not for recreational purposes. These teams will be highly competitive in nature as they will be competing against private school teams in SC and NC.

All players are contributing members of the team and will be challenged in practice sessions. They will be provided opportunities during game situations to display their athletic skills. It should be the understanding of every parent and player that participation is a privilege. Hard work, ability, faithfulness and opportunity provide the arena for young people to be part of a solid athletic program. Participation in events is not guaranteed. It is earned. One long range goal of this program is to provide opportunities to compete for Homeschool titles on the state, regional and national levels.

Claiming Christ in all we do for His glory is foundational to this program. With this in mind, we want to undertake the opportunity entrusted to us as coaches and staff to be positive role models with the desire of building and shaping lives through our athletic program.

Spring is the time for plans to be made for fall sports teams. At this time, we need to know an interest level for the following:

- Girl's varsity volleyball with possible junior high team based on interest hopefully practicing at Taylors 1st Baptist.
- Boy's varsity soccer with possible junior high team based on interest hopefully practicing at Herdklotz Park.

No money is needed at this time but we must have the registration forms completed at the time of co-op registration to be able to secure a schedule. We are trying to keep fees under \$75 per player per sport.
